## Vestry Planning Day Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> June

The Vestry planning day was a busy, thoughtful and enjoyable day. Saro led vestry through a work shop to identify common purpose, leadership, structures & processes, strengths & gaps, achieving our plan & purpose. The work continued at the June Vestry meeting and there will be another session scheduled for Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> July.



## Summary of discussion, 14 July meeting

- A good response to the emergency food collection. Two emergency storage areas will be established -ie- in the church and hall areas.
- EQS project: the architect is progressing documentation for building consent
- EQS fundraising update
- Rewiring of St Pauls house section of the hall complex is progressing. This will be funded by a grant from the Hilda Curtis trust.
- Discussion document circulated on youth at St Pauls.
- Finances: payments \$30,000 which included payment of the engineers design report. Income \$11,000 which was sufficient to cover routine expenditure & wages.
- St Paul's distribution of Ezee meals will discontinue. This decision has been made due to the recent supply issues and the MOH product recall.
- A meeting is scheduled with the regional Public Health co ordinators of the Community Vegetable Box project. This project is well established at St David's Naenae.
