Prior to this vestry meeting a pre workshop survey was circulated & filled out by vestry members.

Saro updated vestry on the survey response & introduced the workshop process. The workshop will cover a common purpose, leadership, structures & processes, strengths & gaps, achieving our plan & purpose.

Finance: May payments were higher than usual i.e. contained 30% staffing costs, 30% operational expenses & 30% non routine payments which included payment for the new church microphone system.

Earthquake strengthening donations of approx \$7,600 were received in May.

The Wn Diocesan roadshow to update parishes on the new charities legislation will be attended by five finance committee members and the auditor.

Finance committee to develop guidelines for projects to assist with scoping, budgeting, cash handling, marketing etc

Play group will have its three yearly Ministry of Education inspection this month.
